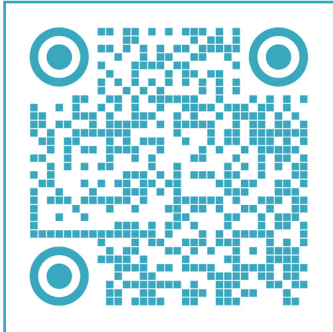

JFSA administers scholarships, grants, and interest free loans to students in the greater Cleveland area enrolled in accredited institutions of higher education. Scholarships are awarded in competition with other students who have met application requirements. Some scholarships are renewable. Grants and loans are based on need and available funds. Funds are intended to be used toward tuition and education expenses. All students must reapply each year.

## CORE PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

- High school senior, college undergraduate, or graduate student who identifies as Jewish
- Full time student
- Attending an accredited 4-year college (no online programs)
- Resident of Cuyahoga, Summit, Portage, Geauga, Medina, Lorain or Lake counties
- Has applied to or exhausted other sources and still needs additional finances to complete education
- 2.5 GPA minimum
